




#### Dillons Community Rewards program

Last year, we learned that we can register with the Dillons Community Rewards program and earn money for our Chapter. After you register your Dillons card, each time it is scanned the Chapter will receive a small rebate. This in no way impacts your Dillons gas points or any other benefits. It is merely a way for Dillons to give back to the communities where their customers shop.

Below are instructions for registering your Dillons card. Once registered, allow two weeks and then you should see a statement at the bottom of your receipt that indicates that you have affiliated your card so that the Wichita ASG Chapter will receive your rebate. Please take a few minutes to do this! It's free money for us.

If you already did this last year, you have to re-enroll to continue donating to our Chapter.

#### To Re-enroll:

- 1. You should have received an email from Dillons with a link to re-enroll. Just follow the directions in the email.
- 2. If you did not receive the email, you can still re enroll. Go online to register on line at <a href="www.dillons.com/communityrewards">www.dillons.com/communityrewards</a> and sign in with your email and password. You will see your donations for the last quarter and an option to re-enroll.
- 3. Click on Re-Enroll Now and type Wichita American Sewing Guild in the box and click search.
- 4. Click on the circle to choose our chapter and click Enroll. You will then see your Account Summary page with a confirmation that you have successfully enrolled in the Community Rewards Program.

#### If you have an online account with Dillons but have not yet enrolled:

- 5. Go online to www.dillons.com/communityrewards and sign in with your email and password.
- 6. Click on Enroll Now and type Wichita American Sewing Guild in the box and click search.
- 7. Click the circle to choose our chapter and click Enroll. You will then see your Account Summary page with a confirmation that you have successfully enrolled in the Community Rewards Program.

#### If you have a Dillons card but have not registered it online:

- 8. Go online to www.dillons.com/communityrewards and click Create an Account.
- 9. Enter your email and password (twice) and your zip code and click find.
- 10. Select a Preferred Store from the drop down list. Then click create an account.
- 11. You will get a confirmation that your account has been created. Enter your Dillons Plus Card number and your last name and click save.
- 12. You will see your Account Summary Page. Scroll down and follow steps 6 and 7 above.
