- 1 cup water chestnuts-diced
- 2 cups sour cream
- 1 cup Mayo (Hellmann's)
- 1 pkg. Frozen chopped, thawed, drained and squeeze out all the liquid

Chicken O'Lay

- 1 can cream mushroom soup
- 1 can cream chicken soup
- 1 cup sour cream.
- 2 tbsp. chopped onion
- 2 cups grated cheddar cheese (save 1/2 cups for cheese for topping)
- 3 to 4 cups cooked, cubed chicken
- 12 flour tortillas
- 17 oz. jar salsa

Mix the cream soups together with the sour cream and onions. Tear tortillas into about 6 or 8 pieces. In your SLOW COOKER layer tortillas, soup mixture, chicken then salsa. Repeat till done. Cook on LOW for 4 to 5 hours. At the last 30 minutes add the 1/2 cup of cheese.




