FITTING FOCUS

Crotch depth adjustment: If you have a flat bottom or if you always just have extra room in the derriere try making an 'L' crotch instead of a 'J' crotch. Come down from the waist to the inseam more straight down and then make a tight turn that more resembles an 'L'. You can also take in a little bit in the inside leg seams as well.

Gaping necklines. First, always make sure that the shoulder on the pattern matches your shoulders. Make them more square if you have square shoulders. If that takes care of the problem great! If not, make a pattern adjustment at the neckline edge that extends to the armhole. Cut a line from neckline to armhole and overlap the pattern on the neckline side until you have eliminated that unnecessary fullness. Good Luck!
