1\2 yd fusible poly fleece
1\2 yd light-weight fusible web
thread and decorative thread
sharp pointed scissors or rotary cutter and mat
fray stop or check

Santa Pail by Barb Kroeger

 $1\4$  yd fabric for outside, bottom and handle lining and bottom lining  $1\4$  yd

Buttons for handle

Jingle bell for hat or button

appliqués – Santa body and hat 1\8 yd fabric scraps of materials for hat band, face, beard and mustache.

fusible web 1\4 yd
cotton batting 1\2 yard
black beads or embroidery floss for eyes
blush for cheeks

Luggage Tags by Barb Blackman

Scrap of fabric 3" x 12"

Heavy wt. iron on interfacing

Vinyl to put on top – can be plastic for templates or anything you can sew through.

Glass Jar Pin Cushion by Lana Klager

Wide Mouth Canning Jar with lid and ring 9" square of fabric to make pin cushion Items to fill jar- buttons, etc.

thread and needle and scissors

#### Strawberry Slush

1 1/2 C. Sugar (Dissolve in 2 C. cold water)

Add 2 small cans or 1 large can of frozen orange juice (Diluted with 1 can water)

Add 2 1/2 cans crushed pineapple with juice

6 bananas mashed

2-10 oz. frozen strawberries thawed

Mix well and put in freezer- stir hourly to make slushy. Freeze till solid. Take out of freezer several hours before serving.

Mix above together by hand, then stir in 1 C. Gold Metal Flour.




