

Suggestions for stocking stuffers from the Wichita and Andover Children's home include: shampoo, conditioner, combs, brushes, toothpaste, hair grease or spray, deodorant, tampons, travel-size hygiene items, nail care items, disposable razors/shaving cream, lip balm, hair accessories, socks and underwear. Infants/toddlers need bath wash, diapers, wipes, pull-ups, diaper cream, socks and underwear, bottles, pacifiers, sleepers, onesies, toddler toys. Kids could use UNO and other card games, art supplies, school supplies (notebook paper, pens, mechanical pencils, 3-ring binders, sturdy back packs, journals), sleeping bags, flip-flops (shower shoes), socks, T-shirts, PJs, sweatpants, hoodies. They'd appreciate any activity passes (bowling, movies, museums, sports events, skating), MP3 players w/ear buds, LEGOs, RC cars, Science/educational kits, Puzzles (preschool to 100+ pieces), Xbox and Wii games (rated E), Current DVD movies (G, PG, PG-13), and bicycles for teens. Individually packaged snack foods, such as juice boxes, fruit cups, fast food gift cards also welcomed.


