ASG has added a new 2020 membership benefit for all members. Webinars, via ZOOM, from nationally recognized sewing experts that normally give seminars across the country, but whose schedules have been interrupted by socializing restriction's due to covid-19 pandemic. These presenters all have websites where you can learn more about them, their patterns and u-tube videos.
