Tips and Tricks from Our Members

From Shannon Shoemaker:



Cut the bottom out of a large laundry soap container, then it can be used as a "funnel" when spraying 505 temporary adhesive to fabric or stabilizer.

The laundry soap (or any other large container with a handle) contains the spray to only the area you want it applied, therefore eliminating "over-spray"

From Jean Horstman:



Do not lock your sewing machine in your car trunk when your car battery has decided to die \otimes . NO manual release....oh my!

From Cindy McMurray:



I needed a large space for cutting out fabric. The dining room table is too low. So, I bought an inflatable twin size bed and put it on the table. I added a piece of pink rigid foam on top of that and my cutting mats on that. It brings my work up to the right height and saves my back!

From Cherie Davis:



- 1. Use over the door shoe holder to store stabilizer.
- 2. Use tiny hair ties to put around bobbins to hold the thread.
