## **Boxy Bag from Kay Cass**

What can you do with a 5x9 piece of quilted fabric?

- 1. Quilt your fabric, I used my embroidery machine. If you want the design, email Kay Cass (kaycass@hotmail.com).
- 2. Sew zipper on the right side of each short edge. Zipper teeth facing the right side of fabric & to the inside.
  - If you place the zipper just past the raw edge it will create a clean finish on the back side
  - Turn the zipper to the wrong side and stitch down from the wrong side
- 3. Add zipper pull making sure the zipper tape ends are the same length

At this point you decide what type of bag you want.

- Flat with zipper on top,
- Flat with zipper 1" from the top
- Flat with zipper in the center
- Boxy bag

## Boxy bag

- 4. Find the center of piece on the long edge, pin tabs on the inside at the center, add hardware if needed.
  - a. To make tabs, cut coordination fabric 2"x5", bring raw edges of long side to center, press
    & fold again in half. Top stitch on both long edges. You can also use ribbon.
- 5. With RIGHT SIDES together match center of zipper teeth to the center of the long edge, where the tabs are. *MAKE SURE THE ZIPPER IS PARTIALLY OPEN*. Clip and sew ¼ from raw edge.
- 6. Cut corners, ¾ from fold & 1" from raw edge. This will make a 1" box after sewn.
- 7. Make the boxed ends by lining up the cut edges. It helps to stick your finger inside to push the fabric around. Stitch ¼ "from the raw edge, stitch so the zipper tape stays flat. Finish the raw edge.
- 8. Turn
